

UPPER HANOVER TOWNSHIP
PAVILION RENTAL RULES AND GUIDELINES

- The time frame listed on the permit includes set up and clean up. Other groups may be renting the pavilion before or after your group.
- All Upper Hanover Township Parks and Recreation Rules and Regulations shall remain in effect at all times throughout the duration of the permit. It is the responsibility of the permit holder to assure compliance by all group participants.
- All groups are limited to use of the facilities noted on their permit. All other park amenities (tot lot, field areas, trail, etc.) are open to the general public on a first come – first serve basis.
- The pavilion must be cleaned and vacated by the stated ending time.

The following are NOT permitted:

1. ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES – *The uses of alcohol and controlled substances are strictly prohibited.*
2. SMOKING – *The use of all tobacco products is prohibited within all park areas.*
3. FIRES AND COOKING GRILLS – *No fires shall be made within any park area. The use of all cooking grills is prohibited.*
4. GLASS CONTAINERS – *Glass containers are prohibited at the pavilion.*
5. VENDORS /SALES TO PUBLIC – *No person shall sell or set up any booth, table or stand for the sale of any article or service without the specific consent of the Township.*
6. FIREWORKS – *All fireworks of any kind are prohibited.*
7. VEHICLES ON THE PARK FIELDS/WALKING PATHS – *Driving on the walking paths or parking on the grass area is strictly prohibited.*
8. NAILS, TACKS, OR STAPLES – *Do not attach decorations by nails, tacks or staples on pavilion poles, picnic tables, etc.*

CONCESSION STAND GUIDELINES

- Only electrical plug-in appliances are allowed. No open flames or grills.
- No pressure cookers, deep fryers or other similar appliances are allowed.
- All appliances should be placed only on the concession stand counter and not on the floor.
- Do not overload individual plugs with extension cords. No more than two appliances for each electrical outlet.
- Do not leave plugged in and activated appliances unattended.
- Following the conclusion of concession stand use, the concession stand floor and all counter tops must be cleaned.
- Remove all food items from the concession stand and the refrigerator at the conclusion of the rental.
